

# RIDGELINE MALLARD PANTS

I have worn these pants on a number of hunts now including chasing pigs, out on the hill thar hunting and also opening morning on the ducks. On any hunting trip they certainly would be on my list for sure. They performed very well, they are nice, warm and comfortable to wear. The two waterproof zip pockets are great and as an extra they also have one velcro sealed internal map pocket membrane which is an awesome idea. Fitted with belt loops they also have a drawstring elasticised waistband. One of the many great features of these pants is the 1/3 leg zip with storm cover. These have a good solid strip of strong velcro, which means, yes, you can slide these pants on and off with ease over your boots. At the bottom of the pants there are three domes which you can secure to your comfort, so it's nice and firm around the top of your boots. Sizes range from XS right through to 5XL, made from the same light weight fabric as the Mallard Jacket that I reviewed in issue 48. These pants have fantastic waterproof and breathability ratings, so they're great for any event. They have a waterproof rating of 10,000mm H2O and breathability rating of 1,000g/m2/24hrs.
